The purpose of these guidelines is to assist applicants to correctly complete the relevant forms and ensure all required documents are submitted so as to prevent delays in processing the application.

These guidelines should not be used as a substitute for the Petroleum and Petroleum Products Regulations 2004. These Regulations serve as the legal framework on which these guidelines are based to provide ease in application while remaining in full compliance with the law.

GUIDELINES



Consumer Installation

A consumer Installation means a petroleum and petroleum products installation, including: any PUMP, STORAGE TANK, PIPING used IN RELATION THERETO, for the purpose of dispensing petroleum and petroleum products into one's own or hired product consuming vehicle or equipment.

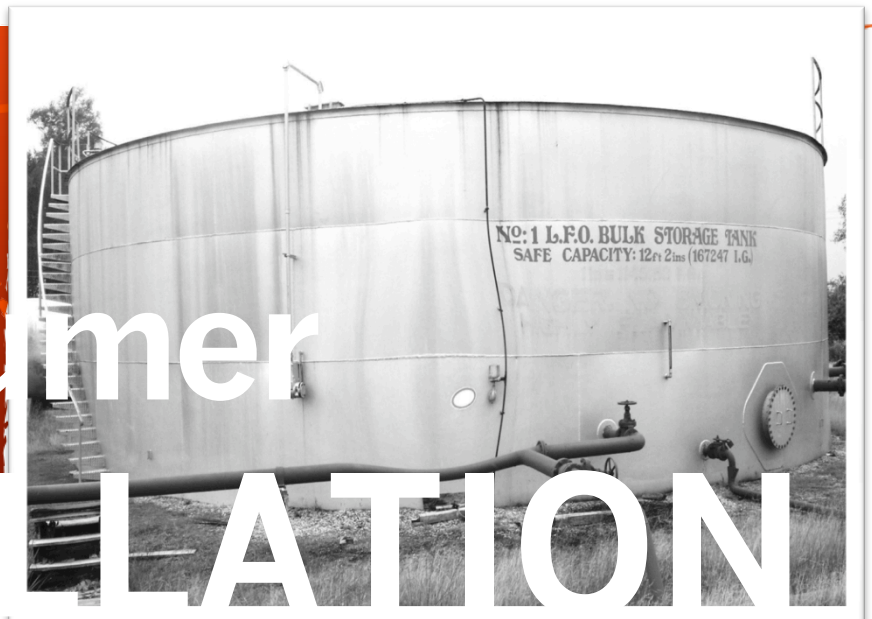
Who requires this Licence?

A consumer installation licence is required for persons who store 2000 litres or more of petroleum or petroleum products.

A person shall submit a separate application for EACH consumer installation he intends to operate.



Consumer INSTALLATION

How Can a Licence Be Obtained?

Ensure the following steps are complied with:

1) Obtain/Uplift an Application Form from the
GEA Licensing Office at 295 Quamina Street
OR download one from our website:
www.gea.gov.gy

2) Fill the Application Form, including all
relevant information in the spaces provided.



3) Attach

The following :

- Form of Identification: passport or Identification card and, in the case of a non-Caricom national, permanent residence permit or valid work permit.
- Business registration or incorporation documents.
- Environmental permit, if required from EPA
- Police Clearance Certificate
- Proof that the applicant operates a commercial or industrial undertaking or a mine or is a bona fide farmer
- Transport/Lease/ title or land claim.
- If not a first time applicant, a tax compliance.
- Approved plans, final designs or construction drawings of all buildings, roadworks, structures and plant to be erected on the proposed premises, including the location and a general layout plan, including confirmation of meeting industry standards with respect to buildings, quantities and sizes of tanks, number of pumps, piping and materials
- Petroleum licence from Guyana Fire Service (GFS).
- Two coloured photographs of the storage area.

NOTE WELL

- A fee is required for the issuance of licence.
- If applicable, *authorization to apply/power of attorney/probate/letters of administration.*
- Identification Document of applicant & person authorized to transact business.
- Special circumstances- letter with affidavit attached, attesting to special circumstances surrounding inability to furnish requested document(s).
