Questions

Q: Are all certification required?

A: It doesn't have to be all, the MPW mandatorily requires the UL and RoHS. Any additional certificate is acceptable.

- Q: Does the MPW requires a US or European certified product?
- A: (US standard) UL certification is a must.
- Q: Would IP 65 be accepted?
- A: Only IP 66 will be accepted.
- Q: How will the IP 66 be tested?

A: The certification process is important, if suspected to be non-compliant, will be taken to laboratory for testing.

- Q: Is the Ministry willing to test the samples presented by the bidders?
- A: No, only if an agreement from the bidder is included to foot all associated bills incurred.
- Q: What measures can be placed to have theft proof lights?
- A: Features such as; special screws, antitheft bolts and locking devices.
- Q: Is there a bar code that can be used?
- A: There is an identifier, "GoG LED" that must be used (screen printed on each lamp, not stickers that can be easily removed)
- Q: Is there an advantage if you provide 10 years warranty?
- A: No, but we will accept 10 years if we don't have to pay an additional cost.
- Q: Is there a specific requirement on the driver quality and mean time between failure?
- A: This will be reviewed by the technical team of the MPW and GEA which will be communicated to the bidders accordingly.
- Q: What is the minimum volts that can be used.
- A: 85-277 volts is acceptable.
- Q: Can delivery time be extended to 120 days?
- A: It will remain at 90 days.
