EDUCATION terms and conditions

Introduction

Educational projects are defined as those that, with or without cost, are in the process of implementation or have already been executed. These may include course delivery, theoretical and applied research, programs for the adoption of measures in educational institutions or other related centers, as well as the development of training programs or technologies. Their main objective is to contribute to the reduction of CO₂ equivalent emissions in processes, improve energy efficiency in organizations, or promote the adoption of non-conventional renewable energies.

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Applications

All public and private entities from member countries of the Latin American Energy Organization (OLADE) that have implemented projects from January 1, 2022, to June 1, 2025, are eligible to apply.

Applications will be accepted only by email at premio.excelenciaenergetica@olade.org until July 27, 2025, inclusive.

The application consists of:

1. **General application form:** *Annex I (General Application Form)*
2. **Project presentation:** maximum of 3,000 words, according to the specifications found in *Annex II (Project Presentation Template)*.
3. **Letter** signed by a representative of the institution where the project is being implemented, indicating their willingness to participate and accepting these guidelines. See *Annex III (Acceptance Letter Template)*.
4. **Graphic material:** The company logo must be submitted in vector format (.eps or .pdf) and at least five high-quality photos (300 dpi) to be used in future promotional materials. One of the photos must be of the entity's facade. It can be a frontal or aerial photograph. It is important that it be a representative photo of the entity. The remaining photos must be of the measures and activities (implementation, management, training, promotion) presented. All graphic material must be accompanied by a brief description of its content.
5. **Audiovisual material:** A video of no more than three minutes must be submitted describing the submitted project and showing the main measures implemented.
6. Up to a maximum of five pages of **supporting information**.

The submission will not be considered valid if all the requested elements from items 1 to 5 are not submitted.

Project Presentation

The "Project Presentation" document must include the following information as a minimum:

- Description of the academic impact on the educational community and the community.
- If the submission is in subcategory 2, Applied Projects, the information must be submitted as described in the guidelines for the other categories of this award, as applicable.
- If the submission is in subcategory 1, Academic Projects, the following information must be submitted:
 - o People impacted (include accounting methodology).
 - o Submit a description of the academic impact on the educational community and the community.
 - o Number of people trained or informed on topics that impact a reduction in CO2 equivalent emissions in processes, improve the energy efficiency of processes or organizations, or collaborate with the implementation of non-conventional renewable energies (only for subcategory 2).
 - o Project continuity: Indicate the next steps for the project.
 - o Description of the academic impact on the educational community and the community.
- Communication and dissemination policies: Describe the dissemination policies implemented, future communication plans, and the number of people impacted. Also, describe the results achieved through your dissemination and communication policies.

All information provided by the applicant is considered to be their intellectual property and is true. It is the participant's responsibility to take the necessary steps to ensure this.

Olade reserves the right to modify the rules of the Olade Award for Energy Excellence at any time during this call. Any modifications will be published on the institutional website. Any modifications to the rules will be made prior to the closing date for applications.

Considerations

- Academic projects: Academic projects are defined as courses, studies, educational projects, and theoretical or applied research carried out by these institutions.
- Applied projects: Applied projects are defined as projects that have been implemented for a fee or free of charge, both in the educational field and in third-party locations.
- By submitting their applications, the entities declare that they comply with the applicable national regulations and may be excluded from the award if non-compliance is verified, even after the award has been delivered.
- By submitting their applications, the entities declare that they will allow visits to the facilities, provide additional information, and/or present the project to the Evaluation Committee, if requested.
- The entities will allow OLADE to use information about their achievements to promote efficient energy use.
